Glue residues and stubborn stains can be removed with Elatex Universal Stain Remover.

Note: Laminated floors or surfaces should never be damp or wet for a longer period of

time. Especially the edges could swell up and change shape. Therefore always wipe with thoroughly wrung-out cloths and ensure that no "pools" are created on the
